MINUTES OF MEETING

July 12, 1981

The annual meeting of the C.W.B.C.A. was convened at 10:45 a.m. with Mr. J. Ranta, the retiring president, presiding. Minutes of the 1980 meeting were read, motion to adopt minutes as read by Mr. Ranta, seconded by Mr. Gregg and passed unanimously.

1. Beach Patrol

The President, Mr. Chapman, read a letter from Water Plat suggesting we show cost of maintaining beach patrols. It was agreed to find out the cost by the President, assisted by Mr. Winterton, and discuss with members what they wish to do.

2. Parade July 4, 1982

After agreeing to participate in the event, and discussing types of entries, it was decided Mr. Lowe would provide a Trailer and Mr. Eriks the boat and then fill it with young children as ambassadors of good will from Crystal Water Beach. The parade is to start at 11 a.m. from Nielsons Lumber and finish at the Lighthouse Park. Bob and Fred Culbert volunteered to make the arrangements.

3. Scottish Dances

Permission was requested to use the Bluff on Sunday August 28th\* from 3 to 5 p.m. to present a troupe of 30 Scottish dancers. Everyone agreed it was a most interesting idea and promised to attend.

4. Drains -- Holiday Lane

Mr. Carter advised drain on north side of Holiday Lane is plugged and water is collecting along the Lane and flowing unchecked over the cliff which will in time erode it badly. Mr. Chapman checked later with Mr. Thorstenson on the method he and the residents of the beach area were handling the same type of problem and found the easiest and cheapest way was to run an 8" pipe down the side of the cliff and Mr. Thorstenson agreed to show the cost of this project. (This last statement to be verified by Chappie.) There will be a two week notice of a work party if it is agreed upon.

5. Drain -- Saturna

Overflowing drain at Mr. Nightingales on Saturna to be checked. Mr. Breckel offered to supply 4" pipe to continue from his house. Notice to be posted for a work party August 26\* to start on this.

\* August 26 is Wednesday -- should be July 26, Sunday?

6. Trees on Bluff

Bob Culbert will get an estimate of the cost and provide work party to assist professional help obtained to trim lower branches of trees on bluff.

7. Stairs to Beach

The two paths leading to the stairs to the beach are in very poor shape after all the rainfall and they have always been a problem and will continue to be so and it was agreed that it would save future time and money to put another flight of stairs from the bluff to connect with the platform of the old stairs thus cutting out the two paths altogether. If possible to start the work in August and, to guarantee success, to have Ray Poirier as foreman and \$500.00 be allocated to construct stairs. Motion passed unanimously.

8. Dues

Motion made by E. Eriks and seconded by Mr. Winterton to raise dues to \$20.00 per year. Passed.

9. Dumping

Motion made that dumping over the cliff be restricted to fine clippings and passed unanimously. Mr. Breckel offered to bring his truck trailer to pick up from every house, notice to be posted of times.

10. Signs

Mr. Lowe volunteered to make up necessary signs regarding parking, fires on beach etc.

11. Bluff Party

Mr. Jack Barber nominated chairman of the annual Bluff Party to be held Saturday August 1<sup>st</sup> at 5 p.m., each family to provide food for themselves and their guests, desserts to be served from the common table. Mr. Breckel volunteered to supply the coffee, Karl Gregg to supply urn, Chairman to look after supplying soft drinks for the children. \$75.00 to be set aside for bingo prizes, to be convened by Messrs. Winterton, Lowe and Chapman. In case of rain, party to be cancelled.

A vote of thanks was given to the retiring president and at 12:25 p.m. Mr. Scott moved the meeting be adjourned, carried unanimously.
