Re: Application by Jack & Glenda Fraser for Operation of Permanent Commercial Bed & Breakfast at Waters Plat, Point Roberts, Washington.

I am writing as President of the Crystal Water Beach Community Association to express the concerns of the property owners of the Crystal Water Beach Plat with respect to the subject application.

As you are aware the Waters Plat property is adjacent to the Crystal Water Beach Plat with both properties fronting on private beach areas on the south foreshore of Point Roberts.

Our two plats have existed for more than thirty years as neighbouring community groups who share the common objective of developing and maintaining a high quality of seasonal residential activity. We are individually and collectively opposed to the establishment of commercial activies within the bounds of either of these long established residential plats.

The specific reasons for our concerns at this time are:

1. the lack of comprehensive zoning in Point Roberts in concert with the random approval of commercial activities would have a <u>detrimental</u> impact on the unique quality of the area and the value of the residential improvements contained therein;

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2. the proposed commercial bed and breakfast facility would create unacceptable levels of traffic and noise which would 🛶 📩 from detrimental to the quiet enjoyment of the residential from properities in the platted areas;

> з. such commercial activity would lead to transient visitors whose actions may lead to unacceptable increases in security measures, common area maintenance costs and public liability insurace premiums for the existing property owners; and,
